Letter group 7

Cut the words. Each sentence has its own color.

Give the children the words of one color. Let them make a sentence with a part of the words. Can they change the sentence by using another word? E.g. Chris found his wallet on the shelf → Chris found his shirt on the shelf / Charlie found his shirt on the shelf / Charlie saw his shirt on the shelf.

To make it easier you can give the first sentence, that's printed bold.
